Owing to the fact that COVID -19 is still hampering our Order, temporary changes must be made to the Constitution and By-Laws for 2021:

- 1. The number of Local Lodge meetings will be determined by individual Lodges themselves.
- The number of members to hold a meeting whether in person, or virtual shall be the same as a quorum (4) with one (1) being an Officer of that Lodge.
- 3. The protocol for such meetings will follow the White Book as much as possible. This again will depend on the format of the meeting.

- 7. When outdoor gatherings open for at least 3-4 persons the outline above may be expanded and again keep members involved and informed.
