Applicants returning to school after an academic hiatus may submit a letter of recommendation from their supervisor from their current/last job.

Attached are the forms you will need to complete the scholarship application process. If you have any questions, please contact a member of the scholarship committee.

The committee must receive your application packet no later than **April 1, 2024**. You can mail your packet to any member of the committee. You could also submit your application to one of the committee members at any lodge meeting before April 1st.
